Please label all supplies, including pencils, with your child's name. Names should also be put on jackets and lunchboxes. Please note: This is a general list per grade. Additional items may be added by individual teachers. Ample time will be given to obtain requested supplies.

Ganon

1. A full set of clothing-labeled in a Ziploc bag (season appropriate)
2. A long sleeve smock
3. A roll of paper towels
4. 2 family photos
5. Individual photo of child (not Ganon Bet)
6. Towel for rest time (not Ganon Bet)
7. 1 package of baby wipes
8. 100% cotton white pillowcase
9. One 1 inch binder

Gan

1. A full set of clothing-labeled in a Ziploc bag (season appropriate)
2. A smock

5. Two 1.5 inch binders - Gan Daled only

First Grade

Please note: We work in clusters and supplies are shared communally.

1. 1 box of 8 washable markers
2. 1 box of 16 crayons

6. 1 marble notebook (composition)
7. 2 large erasers
8. 1 box of Ziploc sandwich bags

Second Grade

1. 6 pencils
2. 3 coated or plastic pocket folders – **bottom pockets, not side**
3. 2 marble composition books
4. 1 spiral notebook – 70 pages
5. One 1 inch hard cover binder **with clear pocket on the cover**
6. 1 box Ziploc bags – 50 ct. sandwich bag size
7. 3x5 index card box – approximately 3x3x5 (holds 200 cards)
8. 1 pack 3x5 dividers – paper not plastic, at least 22 cards
9. 2 packages 100 ct. 3x5 index cards
10. 1 page 1"x2^{5/8}" blank labels (30 per page)
11. Headphones (Please label and place in a labeled Ziploc bag.)

Third Grade

1. 3 marble notebooks (wide ruled)

Fourth Grade

Fifth Grade

5. 4 individual spiral notebooks- red, green, yellow, blue (with perforated pages) with matching color coded pocket folders
6. 1 additional pocket folder
7. 24 pencils
8. Manual pencil sharpener
9. 16 pens- black ink
10. 1 pack of (4) highlighters
11. 1 pack of 8 thick markers

Middle School (Grades 6, 7, 8)

All middle school children will be issued an iPad at the beginning of the school year. We have adjusted the school supplies list accordingly; please purchase the following school supplies.

As iPads will be distributed over the first week of school, we recommend the students bring a separate homework pad as well. Please send headphones to school with your child. (Please label and place in a Ziploc bag).

Middle School Judaic Studies:

Students may opt to use their iPads for note taking purposes

- 4 notebooks or 1 binder with subject dividers for Judaic studies classes
- 4 folders for Judaic studies classes
- pocket-size *Tanach*
- pocket-size Hebrew-English dictionary (Oxford edition preferred)

Additional supplies for Grades 6, 7, 8—to be kept at home:

The Five Books of Torah with *Rashi* - חמשה חומשי תורה עם רש"י

In order to eliminate the burden of “shlepping” books back and forth, we are requesting that the Judaic texts listed above be kept at home. Students who do not have these books in their home libraries will be able to purchase used copies at a nominal fee. Many general studies texts will be distributed and kept at home. Extra sets of Judaic and general studies texts will be available for classroom use.
